BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. REPORT; CERTIFIED DRIVING SCHOOL PASS RATES.

The legislature encourages the commissioner of public safety, in conjunction with appropriate stakeholders, to track and share student pass rates for each certified driving school and investigate high student failure rates when they occur for a given school. By December 15, 2022, the commissioner must report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over transportation finance and 1.10 policy on whether this recommendation has been implemented, is in the process of being 1.11 implemented, or will not be implemented. If the recommendation has been implemented, 1.12 the commissioner must describe how the recommendation was implemented and the outcome 1.13 of the implementation. If the recommendation is in the process of being implemented, the 1.14 commissioner must provide the implementation timeline and a description of how the 1.15 recommendation is being implemented.
