1.2 **which was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 3581:** A bill for an act relating to driver and vehicle services; allowing additional
1.4 entities to provide copies of certain driver and vehicle records; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.5 2020, sections 168.002, by adding a subdivision; 168.327, subdivisions 2, 3; 171.01, by
1.6 adding a subdivision; Minnesota Statutes 2021 Supplement, sections 168.327, subdivision
1.7 1; 169.09, subdivision 13.

1.8 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.9 Page 1, line 12, after "171" insert "who provides all driver services, excluding
1.10 International Registration Plan and International Fuel Tax Agreement transactions"

1.11 Page 3, line 13, strike "to a request for transmittal through a computer modem" and
1.12 insert "online"

1.13 Page 4, line 13, delete "171.01, subdivision 33a" and insert "168.002, subdivision 12a"


1.14 Page 6, line 11, delete the new language and insert "Of the fees collected by a full-service
1.15 provider under this paragraph, ten percent must be transmitted to the commissioner to be
1.16 deposited into the general fund, and the remainder must be retained by the provider."

1.17 Page 6, delete lines 12 and 13

1.18 Page 6, delete section 6

1.19 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.20 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Civil
1.21 Law and Data Practices Policy. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
