Host county responsibility. A host county is responsible for funding all aspects 1.9 of guideways using nonstate sources. This includes, but is not limited to, costs for: 1.10 (1) planning, design, engineering, construction, prerevenue operations, and other costs 1.11 associated with guideway development that exceed federal, state, local government, or other 1.12 funds dedicated to the guideway.
