The North Metro Mayors Association supports SF4395 and the effort to invest in the Trunk Highway 610/East River Road interchange project in Coon Rapids.

The TH 610 and East River Road interchange project is a vital project that will further amplify the efficient movement of commerce and passengers through the North Metro region and further enhance Minnesota's statewide transportation system.

As TH 610 continues to grow as a major route of choice for commerce, commuters and economic development in the growing North Metro, addressing the lack of access to and from TH 610 becomes less of a local option and more of a critical regional necessity.
