

1.1 **Senator Lang from the Committee on Veterans and Military Affairs Finance and**
1.2 **Policy, to which was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 4233:** A bill for an act relating to the military; appropriating money for holistic
1.4 health and fitness program for Minnesota Army National Guard.

1.5 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.6 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.7 "Section 1. Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 12, article 1, section 36, subdivision
1.8 4, is amended to read:

1.9			11,114,000
1.10	Subd. 4. Enlistment Incentives	11,114,000	<u>13,114,000</u>

1.11 The base for this appropriation in fiscal year
1.12 2024 and each fiscal year thereafter is
1.13 \$12,114,000.

1.14 The appropriations in this subdivision are
1.15 available until June 30, 2025, except that any
1.16 unspent amounts allocated to a program
1.17 otherwise supported by this appropriation are
1.18 canceled to the general fund upon receipt of
1.19 federal funds in the same amount to support
1.20 administration of that program.

1.21 If the amount for fiscal year 2022 is
1.22 insufficient, the amount for 2023 is available
1.23 in fiscal year 2022."


1.24 Amend the title as follows:

1.25 Page 1, line 2, delete everything after "money for" and insert "enlistment incentives;"

1.26 Page 1, line 3, delete "for Minnesota Army National Guard"

1.27 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.28 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Finance.
