S.F. No. 2968 – Adult and children foster care modifications and appropriation

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Section 1 (245A.11, subd. 7) provides that the variance requirements for alternate overnight supervision do not apply to community residential settings.

Section 2 (245A.11, subd. 7a) removes mentions of and citations to community residential settings from statute allowing commissioner to grant a license to a residence that does not have a caregiver during normal sleeping hours but uses monitoring technology.

Section 3 (256B.0918) amends employee scholarship program to create home and communitybased services employee scholarship grant program. Modifies eligibility requirements, adds application requirements, amends the provider reporting requirements, and removes the commissioner's annual report to the legislature.

Section 4 (256B.5012) increases operating payment rates for intermediate care facilities for people with developmental disabilities equal to five percent of the rates in effect December 31, 2022.

Section 5 creates a child care relief grant program for direct support professionals that provides a grant award up to \$100 per month for 12 months to eligible direct support professionals with one child in out-of-home child care or up to \$200 per month for professionals with two or more children in out-of-home child care.

Section 6 creates a direct support professionals and supervisor employee retention payments program to retain employees through December 31, 2022. Provides a retention payment of \$1,500 to eligible direct support professionals and frontline supervisors.

Section 7 appropriates money for the home and community-based services employee scholarship grant program.

Section 8 appropriates money for the direct support professional child care relief grant program.

Section 9 appropriates money for the direct support professional and frontline supervisor employee retention payments.
