

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 2843 as follows:

1.3 "Sec. 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 609.035, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Conduct; multiple crimes; chargeable for one offense.** Except as
1.5 provided in subdivisions 2, 3, 4, ~~and 5, 6, and 7~~, and in sections 609.2114, subdivision 3,
1.6 609.251, 609.2691, 609.486, 609.494, 609.585, and 609.856, and Minnesota Statutes 2012,
1.7 section 609.21, subdivision 1b, if a person's conduct constitutes more than one offense under
1.8 the laws of this state, the person may be punished for only one of the offenses and a
1.9 conviction or acquittal of any one of them is a bar to prosecution for any other of them. All
1.10 the offenses, if prosecuted, shall be included in one prosecution which shall be stated in
1.11 separate counts.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2022, and applies to crimes
1.13 committed on or after that date.

1.14 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 609.035, is amended by adding a subdivision to

1.16 Subd. 7. **Exception; certain theft offenses.** Notwithstanding section 609.04, a
1.17 prosecution or conviction for violating section 609.52, subdivision 3a, paragraph (b), is not
1.18 a bar to conviction of or punishment for any other crime committed by the defendant as
1.19 part of the same conduct.

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2022, and applies to crimes
1.21 committed on or after that date."
