

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 1513 as follows:

1.2 Page 8, after line 2, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 6. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 609.855, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Unlawfully obtaining services; misdemeanor.** (a) A person is ~~guilty~~
1.5 ~~of a misdemeanor~~ who intentionally obtains or attempts to obtain service for himself, herself,
1.6 or another person from a provider of public transit or from a public conveyance by doing
1.7 any of the following may be punished as provided in paragraph (c) or (d):

1.8 (1) occupies or rides in any public transit vehicle without paying the applicable fare or
1.9 otherwise obtaining the consent of the transit provider including:

1.10 (i) the use of a reduced fare when a person is not eligible for the fare; or

1.11 (ii) the use of a fare medium issued solely for the use of a particular individual by another
1.12 individual;

1.13 (2) presents a falsified, counterfeit, photocopied, or other deceptively manipulated fare
1.14 medium as fare payment or proof of fare payment;

1.15 (3) sells, provides, copies, reproduces, or creates any version of any fare medium without
1.16 the consent of the transit provider; or

1.17 (4) puts or attempts to put any of the following into any fare box, pass reader, ticket
1.18 vending machine, or other fare collection equipment of a transit provider:

1.19 (i) papers, articles, instruments, or items other than fare media or currency; or

1.20 (ii) a fare medium that is not valid for the place or time at, or the manner in, which it is
1.21 used.

1.22 (b) Where self-service barrier-free fare collection is utilized by a public transit provider,
1.23 it is a violation of this subdivision to intentionally fail to exhibit proof of fare payment upon
1.24 the request of an authorized transit representative when entering, riding upon, or leaving a
1.25 transit vehicle or when present in a designated paid fare zone located in a transit facility.

1.26 (c) A violation of paragraph (a), clause (1), or paragraph (b), is a petty misdemeanor.

1.27 (d) A violation of paragraph (a), clause (2), (3), or (4), is a misdemeanor.

1.28 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2022, and applies to acts
1.29 committed on or after that date."
