S.F. No. 3352 – Law Enforcement Reporting of Carjacking

Section 1 defines "carjacking" for the purposes of the bill.

Section 2 requires local law enforcement agencies and state law enforcement departments to forward the following information to the commissioner of public safety at least quarterly each year:

- the number of carjacking attempts;
- the number of carjackings;
- the number of persons injured in each offense;
- the number of persons killed in each offense; and
- weapons used in each offense, if any.

The bill requires the commissioner of public safety to include the data received in a separate carjacking category in the department's annual uniform crime report.
