The bill appropriates \$250,000 in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to the commissioner of corrections for reimbursement of transportation expenses incurred by counties when returning probationers to the state who are being held in custody under section 243.1605 (Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision). Reimbursements shall be based on a fee schedule agreed upon by the Department of Corrections and Minnesota Sheriff's Association. Reimbursements are limited to the transport of individuals from locations over 250 miles from the office of the sheriff arranging and supervising the offender's return to the state.

This is an ongoing appropriation.
