1.3 **S.F. No. 3487:** A bill for an act relating to public safety; establishing the crime of

 1.5 law enforcement; amending certain burglary crimes following trespass notice; establishing  
 1.6 a time period for a search warrant on financial institutions; amending Minnesota Statutes  
 1.7 2020, sections 13A.02, subdivisions 1, 2; 609.52, subdivision 3; 609.527, subdivision 1, by  
 1.8 adding a subdivision; 609.582, subdivisions 3, 4; 626.15; proposing coding for new law in  
 1.9 Minnesota Statutes, chapter 609.

 1.11 to the Committee on Civil Law and Data Practices Policy. Report adopted.
