We write in support of SF 3175, a resolution seeking Congressional support to name the South St. Paul Post Office in honor of Officer Leo Pavlak. Officer Pavlak age 38, was killed in the line of duty in August of 1933, during a payroll robbery in South St. Paul. Having the post office named in his honor is a true and fitting memorial. In addition, it has great meaning for all law enforcement officers but particularly for those who are his descendants.
