The bill requires the Board of Private Detective and Protective Agent Services to accept proof of required preassignment training from employees of licensed private detectives and protective agents if the training was provided by another Minnesota license holder within the past three years. The bill requires license holders to provide a certificate of preassignment training to employees even when the license holder paid for the training.
