## S.F. No. 3329 – Expanded Use of Tracking Devices During Stolen Vehicle Investigations

**Section 1, paragraph (a)** authorizes the use of mobile tracking devices on stolen vehicles without a court order when:

- 1) the consent of the owner of the vehicle has been obtained, or
- 2) the owner of the motor vehicle has reported to law enforcement that the vehicle has been stolen.

**Paragraph (b)** requires the tracking device be removed from the vehicle if the vehicle is recovered and returned to the owner.

**Paragraph (c)** provides that any tracking device evidence collected after the motor vehicle is returned to the owner is inadmissible.
