

1.1 **Senator Limmer from the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety Finance and**
1.2 **Policy, to which was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 3329:** A bill for an act relating to public safety; authorizing the expanded use
1.4 of tracking devices during stolen vehicle investigations; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020,
1.5 section 626A.35, by adding a subdivision.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 1, after line 12, insert:

1.8 "(b) Within 24 hours of a tracking device being attached to a vehicle pursuant to the
1.9 authority granted in paragraph (a), clause (2), an officer employed by the agency that attached
1.10 the tracking device to the vehicle must remove the device, disable the device, or obtain a
1.11 search warrant granting approval to continue to use the device in the investigation."

1.12 Page 1, line 12, before the period, insert "and the vehicle is occupied when the tracking
1.13 device is installed"

1.14 Page 1, line 13, delete "(b)" and insert "(c)"

1.15 Page 1, line 16, delete "(c)" and insert "(d)"

1.16 Page 1, after line 17, insert:

1.17 **"EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment."**

1.18 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
