Section 1. **Department of Labor and Industry; study of police disability benefit adequacy.** Requires the Department of Labor and Industry to study the adequacy of the current benefits available to disabled or injured police officers. Requires at least one public hearing to be held on the topic. Directs the Public Employees Retirement Association to cooperate in conducting this study. Provides a due date for the report to be submitted to the legislature.
