## S.F. No. 295 – Regulation of radon licensing activities

Section 1. **Rulemaking.** Moves rulemaking authority for radon licensing activities from the Department of Health (MDH) to the Department of Labor and Industry (DLI). Under Minnesota Statutes, section 15.039, subdivision 3, when transferring powers among agencies, the rules in place under the first agency remain effective and are enforceable by the agency to which the first agency's responsibilities were transferred.

Section 2. **Licensing fees.** Transfers radon licensing activities, including collection of licensing and related fees, from MDH to DLI.

Section 3. **Enforcement.** Specifies that radon licensing activities that are being transferred to DLI will be enforced under Ch. 326B (Construction Codes and Licensing).

Section 4. **Appropriation.** Appropriates money to DLI for the radon licensing activities required by the transfer of responsibilities.

Section 5. **Reduction in appropriation.** Makes a corresponding reduction to the Department of Health for radon licensing in relation to the appropriation in section 4.

Section 6. **Revisor's instructions.** Instructs the revisor of statutes to recode the section accordingly.
