S.F. No. 4212 – Modifies the open meeting law

SF 4212 amends the open meeting law for public bodies that meet by interactive technology, by modifying the conditions that must be met to comply with the open meeting law. Under current law, members of public bodies may participate in a meeting from a location that is not open or accessible to the public up to three times in a calendar year if the member has been advised by a health care professional against being in a public place for personal or family medical reasons, and there is a declared state of emergency. This bill removes the state of emergency limitation. This bill is applicable to all governing bodies other than state agencies, committees, or boards.
