A Committee resolution

relating to the Senate contribution to the employee deferred compensation program.

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BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Administration:

- 1. Regular Senate employees may elect to receive an employer-paid contribution to the state deferred compensation program, or elect to convert vacation or compensatory time to deferred compensation as provided in Section 2, paragraphs A and B of the Pre-Tax Accounts, Deferred Compensation and Health Care Savings Plan chapter of the Legislative Coordinating Commission Legislative Plan for Employee Benefits and Policies and as provided in this resolution.
- 2. Beginning July 1, 2022, until June 30, 2023, regular employees of the Senate may elect to convert up to a total of 50 hours of vacation and compensatory time to deferred compensation or may elect to receive an employer-paid matching contribution up to \$1,150.
