## S.F. No. 3898 – Modifying Definition of Attachments and Appurtenances of Cooperative Utility Distribution Lines (as proposed to be amended by A-1)

**SF 3898** modifies the definition of "attachments and appurtenances" of cooperative utility distribution lines. Under current law, distribution lines, including attachments and appurtenances, that are located in rural area, and owned by a cooperative association, are exempt from taxation. Instead, the cooperative pays a tax of \$10 per 100 members. SF 3898 specifies that "attachments and appurtenances" includes all cooperative association-owned metering equipment, streetlights, and any other infrastructure that is physically or electrically connected to the cooperative association's distribution system.

**Effective** beginning with assessment year 2023.
