S.F. No. 3179 – Supplemental 2023 City Aid

This bill proposes to pay supplemental general purpose aid to a city for which the local government aid certified for payment in 2023 is less than the sum of the city’s local government aid and supplemental city aid¹ certified for payment in 2022. The amount of the supplemental 2023 city aid equals the decrease in total certified aid for the city between 2022 and 2023. The amount necessary to pay supplemental 2023 city aid is appropriated from the general fund. Approximately 150 cities would qualify for the supplemental 2023 city aid.

¹ The 2021 Legislature appropriated \$5.5 million for one-time supplemental 2022 city aid to offset reductions in local government aid between 2021 and 2022 for 96 qualifying cities. See [Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 14](#), article 7, section 5.
