RE: Updates to the K-12 Education Tax Credit in Your Supplemental Budget

Dear Governor Walz and Lt. Governor Flanagan,

Thank you for including much-needed and long-overdue updates to the K-12 Education Tax Credit in your supplemental budget.

It has now been 25 years since the income limit for the maximum credit was last changed in 1997. That's why I was thrilled to see you propose increasing the income limit to \$70,000 in your supplemental budget, which would benefit 38,600 Minnesota families.

The benefits of a strong math foundation go far beyond simply getting better grades in math. Kids also gain independence, the ability to think critically and increased confidence. This increased confidence in turn leads to greater overall academic performance and sets them up for future success.
