This is a special local tax (i.e., not applied to the general sales tax base), so the requirements of sec. 297A.99 do not apply.

3471	Marshall Dahms	.5%	Bill seeks to extend the tax first authorized in 2011. Extension would fund construction of a new municipal aquatic center; \$16 million 30 years after projects funded by currently imposed LST are paid
3474	East Grand Forks Johnson	1.25%	Reconstruction, remodeling, upgrades, and additions to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Civic Center Sports Complex; and • VFW Memorial and Blue Line Arena \$21.5 million (as proposed to be amended); 20 years total
3595	Rochester Nelson	.5%	Bill seeks to extend the duration of the currently imposed tax for the following projects: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Housing vitality fund; \$50 million; 4 years • Street reconstruction; \$50 million; 4 years • Flood control and water quality; \$40 million; 3.2 years; and • Regional community and recreation complex; \$65 million; 5.2 years 16.4 years total
