Border-to-Border Broadband Grant Program Budget Request

- **Governor Walz recommends \$138 million in FY24 and \$138 million in FY25 from the general fund for the Border-to-Border Broadband Grant Program.**

Minnesota's Unmet Needs

- About 88% of the state is at the 2026 speed goal of 100/20mbps; only 62% of rural homes and businesses have access at this speed.
- Broadband access is critical for telehealth, business and work needs, education, and economic growth.
- Connecting One Minnesota Event (January 25, 2023 – 242 in-person and 193 on-line registrants)

“Faster Broadband Service Helps Delavan Business Owners”

- Border-to-Border provided a grant to Bevcomm to build out fiber optic cable.
- Provided speeds 60 times faster than their old connection.
- Allows Greg to connect online for his seed treatment system and get IT support.
