#### **Bill Description**

This bill is for grants to retail fuel stations for the upgrade and replacement of dispensers, fuel storage tanks, and other equipment necessary to dispense biofuels to the public in accordance with the biofuel replacement goals established under Minnesota Statutes 239.7911. The grant awards must not exceed 65 percent of the cost of the appropriate technology and must not exceed \$200,000. The commissioner must cooperate with biofuel stakeholders in the implementation of the grant program. An annual report is required.

### **Assumptions**

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) would use existing Biofuels Infrastructure Grant Program procedures, standards, and processes for grantmaking associated with this funding. MDA staff tasks include developing a Request for Proposals, soliciting grant applications, assembling an external grant review team, reviewing and ranking grant proposals, grant contract administration and grant oversight including site visits. Based on past practices of the MDA administering the Biofuels Infrastructure Grant Program, 1 FTE is required to administer approximately 20 grant awards. Grant awards must not exceed \$200,000. Beginning in Fiscal Year 24, the MDA assumes the salary and fringe expense is \$112,000 and non-salary cost would be \$3,022 for a total expense of \$115,022 annually per FTE including the report. The MDA estimates that no additional FTEs or other costs will be needed to do the report. MDA does not assume the funding amount appropriated in this bill and does not assume how many grants will be awarded.
