Bill Description

This bill modifies sections of statute for the advanced biofuel, renewable chemical, and biomass thermal incentive programs. This bill modifies sections of statute that were added in the 2022 legislative session (Minnesota Statutes 41A.16 subd. 7, 41A.17 subd. 6, and 41A.18 subd. 6). The bill makes technical corrections to the sections added in 2022 by modifying eligibility language to better align with existing program language in statute (Minnesota Statutes 41A.16 subd. 1, 41A.17 subd. 1, and 41A.18 subd. 1).

Assumptions

This bill does not impact how the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) would administer the existing advanced biofuel, renewable chemical, or biomass thermal incentive programs. The bill makes technical corrections to eligibility for participants entering the program after April 1, 2023, and MDA assumes there will not be additional work or costs to administer the incentive programs as a result.
