

SF 152 – CHIEF AUTHOR SEN. KLEIN
WATER TREATMENT PLANT (\$5,000,000 REQUESTED)
CITY OF SOUTH ST. PAUL

- **CONSTRUCTION OF TREATMENT PLANT - CITY WELL #3 (\$9,615,000)**
 - Well #3 is a high-capacity source of municipal water and serves as a back-up for the City's primary well (#4), serving more than 3,300 households and 150 businesses in South St. Paul
 - Provides peaking capacity in higher demand (summer) months
 - Radium levels exceed regulatory standards by almost 70%
 - While naturally occurring, radium ingestion/exposure over time can nonetheless slightly elevate the risk of negative health effects with the eyes, kidneys, and other organs
 - Project is Ranked by MDH as #93 on 2023 Project Priority List
