A bill for an act
relating to capital investment; appropriating money to extend the Shorewood Park
Sanitary Sewer District sewer system to Rush Lake and expand treatment facilities in Chisago County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENTS;
CHISAGO COUNTY.
Subdivision 1. Appropriation; expansion of sewer system. \$1,100,000 is appropriated
from the bond proceeds fund to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to Chisago County
to predesign, design, and construct an extension of the Shorewood Park Sanitary Sewer
District sewer system to 20 homes on Rush Lake. This appropriation is not available until
the commissioner of management and budget determines that sufficient resources have been
committed from nonstate sources to complete the project.
Subd. 2. Appropriation; treatment pond. \$1,100,000 is appropriated from the bond
proceeds fund to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to Chisago County to acquire
property and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a sewage treatment pond
in Chisago County for the Shorewood Park Sanitary Sewer District sewer system. This
appropriation is not available until the commissioner of management and budget determines
that sufficient resources have been committed from nonstate sources to complete the project.
Subd. 3. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
the state in an amount up to \$2,200,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

- 2.2 <u>Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.</u>
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
