

Austin's WWTP discharge is nearly 10% of the municipal P discharged in the state.

- Austin WWTP is one of the largest point source Phosphorus producer in the State.
- Phosphorus Reduction  $4.5 \text{ mg/L} \gg 1.0 \text{ mg/L}$
- Activated Sludge Plant
  - o More efficient removal of BOD & TSS
  - o Provides options for future nutrient removal
    - Total Nitrogen
    - Nitrate
