BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. CRANE LAKE; PUBLIC WATER ACCESS.
Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$1,990,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to the town of Crane Lake for predesign
design, site preparation, and construction of a public water access facility for access to
Voyageurs National Park, the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness, and related
waterways. This appropriation includes launch ramps, docks, asphalt parking, stormwater
and aquatic invasive species management, a flush toilet, associated road and utility
improvements, and green space and picnic structures. This appropriation is exempt from
the requirements under Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.86, subdivision 4.
Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
the state in an amount up to \$1,990,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
