1.5	Section 1. SOLID WASTE LANDFILL; ST. LOUIS COUNTY.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$20,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	fund to the Pollution Control Agency for a grant to St. Louis County to acquire property
1.8	for and to design, engineer, and construct a new municipal solid waste landfill that will
1.9	accept new waste and previously processed waste from other landfills in the closed landfill
1.10	program and prevent perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and other
1.11	contaminants from entering Lake Superior. This appropriation is exempt from the
