30,000 Feet's mission is to provide creative learning experiences and tech apprenticeships for marginalized youth.

Since our founding in 2013, we have served over 2,500 students in Saint Paul.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Join 30,000 Feet as we remodel the 4000 sq.ft. to 12,800 sq.ft to be the first premier space where Black youth in Saint Paul can be their authentic selves.

Our Black Arts & Tech Center will provide a space for both creative experiences and overcoming barriers to employment through paid apprenticeships.

The center will include space for a multidisciplinary art studio which includes a recording studio, computer science lab, youth art gallery, literacy classroom, outdoor gathering area for youth performances/ family gatherings, and mental health wellness room.
