1.6 "scrap metal" insert "or motor vehicle"

1.7 Page 3, line 1, after "scrap metal" insert "or motor vehicle"

1.8 Page 3, line 4, after "converters" insert "or motor vehicles"

1.9 Page 7, after line 2, insert:

1.10 "Sec. 10. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 325E.21, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.11 to read:

1.12 Subd. 14. **Vehicle electronic database requirement.** (a) Scrap metal dealers must
1.13 completely and accurately enter all the record information required by subdivision 1b for
1.14 the purchase or acquisition of a motor vehicle into the electronic database approved by the
1.15 commissioner of public safety described in subdivision 13, paragraph (c), by the close of
1.16 business each day.

1.17 (b) A scrap metal dealer must display a sign of sufficient size, in a conspicuous place
1.18 in the premises, which informs all patrons that transactions are reported to law enforcement
1.19 daily.

1.20 (c) The commissioner of public safety must make the information on the electronic
1.21 database available to a law enforcement agency, including federal law enforcement agencies
1.22 and law enforcement agencies with jurisdiction outside of Minnesota.

1.23 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2024."
