

Dear Senators of Commerce and Consumer Protection Committee RE: SF 23

Human sexuality is a deep topic, it runs to the very core of our being and what it means to be human. Who tells us who we are? That is the fundamental question. The Declaration of Independence states that we are to “assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature of Nature’s God entitle them.” Our country was founded upon the idea that there is higher authority than government.
