1.11	defined in section 245I.04, subdivision 2, that seeks to change an individual's sexual
1.12	orientation or gender identity, including efforts to change behaviors or gender expressions
1.13	or to eliminate or reduce sexual or romantic attractions or feelings toward individuals of
1.14	the same gender. Conversion therapy does not include counseling that provides assistance
1.15	to an individual undergoing gender transition, or counseling that provides acceptance,
1.16	support, and understanding of an individual or facilitates an individual's coping, social
1.17	support, and identity exploration and development, including sexual-orientation-neutral
1.18	interventions to prevent or address unlawful conduct or unsafe sexual practices, as long as
