Bill Description

House File 1176-0 amends § 62Q.735, subdivision 1 to remove the alternative approach allowed for dental plan organizations to satisfy the subdivision's provider contract disclosure requirements and effectively subjects these organizations to the general requirements applicable to all health plan companies.

HF1176 amends § 62Q.78 to require that dental provider contracts include a payment method for reimbursement of dental services that does not subject the provider to any fees related to that payment method. The bill further specifies that any fees associated with other payment methods must be disclosed prior to entering into or renewing a dental provider contract.

HF1176 further amends § 62Q.78 to establish requirements under which dental organizations may grant a third-party access to a dental provider contract, a provider's dental care services, or a provider's contractual discounts.

Bill Description

House File 1176-0 alters existing dental fee reimbursement transparency guidelines between dental payors and dental providers. It also establishes guidelines for the practice of "network leasing" between dental organizations, dentists, and third-party organizations.

Assumptions

Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB) administers the State Employee Group Insurance Program (SEGIP) which provides health, dental, life, and other benefits to eligible State employees and their dependents, and quasi-state agencies defined in Minnesota Statute. Health benefits are provided through the self-funded Minnesota Advantage Health Plan (Advantage). SEGIP contracts with three health plan administrators to provide medical benefits and a Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) to provide its prescription drug benefit.

MMB assumes that HF1176-0 does not affect SEGIP's dental plan, as the bill applies only to dental organizations, third party administrators, and dentists, and SEGIP is none of those three entities. Thus, we assume no fiscal impact on SEGIP.
