1.2 **which was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 1949:** A bill for an act relating to gambling; authorizing and providing for
1.4 sports betting; establishing licenses; prohibiting local restrictions; providing for taxation of
1.5 sports betting; providing civil and criminal penalties; providing for amateur sports grants;
1.6 requiring reports; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 245.98,
1.7 subdivision 2; 260B.007, subdivision 16; 609.75, subdivisions 3, 4, 7, by adding a
1.8 subdivision; 609.755; 609.76, subdivision 2; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.9 Statutes, chapters 240A; 299L; 609; proposing coding for new law as Minnesota Statutes,
1.10 chapter 297J.

1.11 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.12 Page 1, line 22, delete the second "or"

1.13 Page 2, line 2, delete the period and insert "; or"

1.14 Page 2, after line 2, insert:

1.15 "(4) the performance of an individual athlete participating in a single game or match of
1.16 a collegiate team."

1.17 Page 18, delete lines 23 and 24

1.18 Page 18, line 25, delete "(c)" and insert "(b)"

1.19 Page 21, after line 29, insert:

1.20 "Subd. 4. Notice. The commissioner shall notify a person whose name has been added
1.21 to the exclusion list under subdivision 1, clause (2), (3), or (4)."

1.22 Page 23, delete lines 26 and 27

1.23 Page 23, line 28, delete "(c)" and insert "(b)" and delete "paragraphs (a) and" and insert
1.24 "paragraph (a)"

1.25 Page 23, line 29, delete "(b)"

1.26 Page 29, line 7, delete the period and insert "; and"

1.27 Page 29, delete lines 8 to 10

1.28 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Health
1.29 and Human Services. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
