BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION; AGRICULTURAL COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION HEALTH PLAN; MARKETING AND STOP LOSS COSTS.

\$4,500,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of commerce for a grant to an agricultural cooperative association health plan organized under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 308B. Of this amount, \$1,500,000 is for marketing and education to raise awareness of the health plan, and \$3,000,000 is to lower premium rates of members and increase enrollment of the at-risk population by reducing the health plan's stop loss costs. This is a onetime appropriation.
