1.3 **S.F. No. 328:** A bill for an act relating to health; requiring manufacturers to report and
1.4 maintain prescription drug prices; requiring the filing of health plan prescription drug
1.5 formularies; health care coverage; establishing requirements for a prescription benefit tool;
1.6 requiring prescription drug benefit transparency and disclosure; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.7 2022, sections 62A.02, subdivision 1; 62J.497, subdivisions 1, 3; 62J.84, subdivisions 2,
1.8 6, 7, 8, 9; 151.071, subdivision 2; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
1.9 chapters 62J; 62Q.


1.10 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.11 Page 14, line 17, delete "quarter" and insert "year"

1.12 Page 15, after line 28, insert:

1.13 "(e) Health plan companies, and managed care plans and county-based purchasing plans
1.14 under section 256B.69 and chapter 256L, may update their formulary or preferred drug list
1.15 quarterly, provided that these changes do not apply to enrollees who are currently taking
1.16 the drugs affected by these changes for the duration of the calendar year."

1.17 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Health
1.18 and Human Services. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
