

1.1 **Senator Klein from the Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection, to**
1.2 **which was re-referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 776:** A bill for an act relating to environment; prohibiting the use of certain
1.4 firefighting foam; appropriating money; allowing certain exemptions; amending Minnesota
1.5 Statutes 2022, section 325F.072, subdivisions 1, 3.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 2, line 29, delete "and"

1.8 Page 2, line 31, delete the period and insert "; and"

1.9 Page 2, after line 31, insert:

1.10 "(3) firefighting foam product included in the database under clause (2) is commercially
1.11 available in quantities sufficient to reliably meet the requirements under Code of Federal
1.12 Regulations, title 14, section 139."

1.13 Page 3, after line 7, insert:

1.14 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 325F.072, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.15 to read:

1.16 Subd. 3a. **Discharge for testing and training.** A person, political subdivision, or state
1.17 agency exempted from the prohibitions under subdivision 3 may not discharge class B
1.18 firefighting foam that contains intentionally added PFAS chemicals for:

1.19 (1) testing purposes, unless the testing facility has implemented appropriate containment,
1.20 treatment, and disposal measures to prevent releases of foam to the environment; or


1.21 (2) training purposes, unless otherwise required by law, and with the condition that the
1.22 training event has implemented appropriate containment, treatment, and disposal measures
1.23 to prevent releases of foam to the environment.

1.24 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2024."

1.25 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.26 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.27 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on
1.28 Environment, Climate, and Legacy. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
