

1.13 a subdivision; 256L.07, subdivision 1; 256L.15, subdivision 2; 270B.14, by adding a
1.14 subdivision; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapters 62J; 62V; 290;
1.15 repealing Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0631, subdivisions 1, 2, 3.

1.16 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill do pass and be re-referred
1.17 to the Committee on Finance. Report adopted.
