OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to Minnesota State High School League; modifying the governing board  
1.3 membership; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 128C.01, subdivision 4.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 128C.01, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 4. **Board.** (a) The league must have at least a 20-member governing board.

1.7 (1) The governor must appoint four members according to section 15.0597. Each of the  
1.8 four appointees must be a parent. At least one of them must be an American Indian, an  
1.9 Asian, a Black, or a Hispanic.

1.10 (2) The Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals must appoint two of its  
1.11 members.

1.12 (3) The remaining 14 members must be selected according to ~~league bylaws~~ the league's  
1.13 constitution.

1.14 (b) The terms, compensation, removal of members, and the filling of membership  
1.15 vacancies are governed by section 15.0575, except that the four-year terms begin on August  
1.16 1 and end on July 31. As provided by section 15.0575, members who are full-time state  
1.17 employees or full-time employees of school districts or other political subdivisions of the  
1.18 state may not receive any per diem payment for service on the board.
