Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 122A.50, is amended to read: 1.5 **122A.50 PREPARATION TIME.** 1.6 Subdivision 1. Preparation time in collective bargaining agreements. Beginning with 1.7 agreements effective July 1, 1995, and thereafter, All collective bargaining agreements for 1.8 teachers provided for under chapter 179A, must include provisions for preparation time or 1.9 a provision indicating that the parties to the agreement chose not to include preparation time 1.10 in the contract. 1.11

A bill for an act

If the parties cannot agree on preparation time the following provision shall apply and be incorporated as part of the agreement: "Within the student day for every 25<u>17</u> minutes of classroom instructional time, a minimum of five additional minutes of preparation time shall be provided to each licensed teacher. Preparation time shall be provided in one or two uninterrupted blocks during the student day. Exceptions to this may be made by mutual agreement between the district and the exclusive representative of the teachers."

1.18Subd. 2. Uninterrupted blocks of preparation time. Preparation time shall be provided1.19in one or two uninterrupted blocks during the student day. Exceptions to this may be made1.20by mutual agreement between the district and the exclusive representative of the teachers.1.21Administrators must not schedule meetings during this preparation time without permission1.22from the local bargaining unit.

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- Subd. 3. Additional preparation time. Additional preparation time must be provided
  to individuals with additional professional engagements, including but not limited to
  supervising extracurricular activities, facilitating special education paperwork, and other
  activities that support the school community. The collective bargaining agreement must
  include provisions for additional preparation time.
  Subd. 4. Flexible learning plans. To meet preparation time requirements under this
- 2.7 section, school districts are encouraged to explore flexible learning plans under section
- 2.8 <u>124D.12</u>, including four-day school weeks.
