S.F. No. 66 – Prohibition on Certain Contributions (as amended by the A-1 amendment)

S.F. 66, as amended by the A-1 amendment, prohibits two types of contributions made by lobbyists, political committees, or political funds, regardless of when the contribution is made. One type of prohibited contribution is to attend an event during the regular session if the event is held by the principal campaign committee of a candidate for the legislature or constitutional office, or by a political party organization within a house of the legislature. The other type of prohibited contribution is for membership or access to a facility operated during the regular session of the legislature by the principal campaign committee of a candidate for the legislature or constitutional office, or by a political party organization within a house of the legislature.
