


1.1 **Senator Carlson from the Committee on Elections, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 746:** A bill for an act relating to elections; permitting a candidate to request  
1.3 the candidate's residential address be classified as private data when the candidate has  
1.4 reasonable fear as to the safety of the candidate or the candidate's family; amending  
1.5 Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 204B.06, subdivision 1b.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 1, line 15, after "(b)" insert "If an affidavit for an office where a residency  
1.8 requirement must be satisfied by the close of the filing period is filed as provided by  
1.9 paragraph (c), the filing officer must, within one business day of receiving the filing,  
1.10 determine whether the address provided in the affidavit of candidacy is within the area  
1.11 represented by the office the candidate is seeking. For all other candidates who filed"

1.12 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Judiciary  
1.13 and Public Safety. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
