## S.F. No. 746 – Candidate's address; private data

**S.F. 746** allows a candidate to have their residential address classified as private if they candidate certifies that the candidate has a reasonable fear for their safety or the safety of their family. Current law allows a candidate to request that their residential address be classified as private data if the candidate certifies that a police report has been submitted, an order for protection has been issued, or the data is otherwise private data pursuant to state law.
