Specifically, we support the following provisions:

Article I's sections on:

- Restoring the vote
- Automatic voter registration
- Pre-registration of 16, 17-year-olds

Article II's sections on:

- Voting instructions and sample ballots in languages other than English
- Intimidation and interference in the voting process

Article III's sections on:

• Democracy Dollar Coupon Program

We urge Sen. Boldon to consider the added impact on the Office of the Secretary of State in its oversight role and as the office responsible for education and outreach designated within SF3/HF3 as well as various other bills.

We respectfully ask that an appropriation be made to the Office of the Secretary of State allowing for responsible oversight and fulfillment of duties so that the risk of unintended consequences is avoided.
