Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 204B.19, subdivision 6, is amended to read: 1.5 Subd. 6. High school students Trainee election judges. (a) Notwithstanding any other 1.6 requirements of this section, a student enrolled in a high school in Minnesota or who is in 1.7 a home school in compliance with sections 120A.22 and 120A.24, who has attained the age 1.8 1.9 of 16 is eligible to be appointed as a without party affiliation trainee election judge in the county in which the student resides, or a county adjacent to the county in which the student 1.10 resides. The student must meet qualifications for trainee election judges specified in rules 1.11 of the secretary of state. A student appointed under this subdivision while enrolled in a high 1.12 school or receiving instruction in a home school may continue to serve as a trainee election 1.13 judge after the student graduates and until the student reaches the age of 18. 1.14 (b) A student appointed as a trainee election judge may be excused from school attendance 1.15 during the hours that the student is serving as a trainee election judge if the student submits 1.16 a written request signed and approved by the student's parent or guardian to be absent from 1.17 school and a certificate from the appointing authority stating the hours during which the 1.18 student will serve as a trainee election judge to the principal of the school at least ten days 1.19
