

1.1 **Senator Carlson from the Committee on Elections, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 1507:** A bill for an act relating to elections; prohibiting intimidation of election  
1.3 officials; prohibiting interference with the performance of a duty of election administration  
1.4 by an election official; prohibiting tampering with or unauthorized access to certain types  
1.5 of election systems and equipment; providing penalties; appropriating money; amending  
1.6 Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 8.31, subdivision 1; 204B.26; 206.845, subdivision 1;  
1.7 211B.32, subdivision 1; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 211B.

1.8 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.9 Page 2, line 1, delete everything after "effective" and insert "the day following final  
1.10 enactment"

1.11 Page 2, after line 7, insert:

1.12 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment."

1.13 Page 2, after line 24, insert:

1.14 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment."


1.15 Page 5, line 8, delete "July 1, 2023" and insert "the day following final enactment"

1.16 Page 5, after line 18, insert:

1.17 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment."

1.18 Page 5, line 20, delete "is" and insert "and \$..... in fiscal year 2025 are"

1.19 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Judiciary  
1.20 and Public Safety. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
