## S.F. No. 2107 – Statement of Economic Interest Modifications

**S.F. 2107** makes modifications to the statement of economic interest. The person filing a statement of economic interest must also include information about the economic interests of the person's spouse. Certain public officials are required to submit more limited information on a statement of economic interest.

**Section 1 [Associated business]** amends the definition of "associated business" to include the individual's spouse.

**Section 2 [Form; general requirements]** amends the requirements for a statement of economic interest. Except as provided in **section 3**, a statement of economic interest must include information for the person's spouse. The person must also include on the statement information on certain contracts, professional licenses, leases, or franchises held or entered into by the person or the person's spouse.

**Section 3 [Form; exceptions for certain officials]** specifies that soil and water conservation district supervisors, watershed management district managers, and watershed management organization members, are required to provide more limited information than other public officials.
